This year, 2018 and 2019 will mark **TheReggae50**; fifty years since the evolution of Jamaican Reggae music from Ska and Rocksteady into the global music phenomena Reggae is today. Since the last six months Martin's International was called upon by several of the reggae foundation entertainers to bring to light the special Golden Reggae milestone Achievement of 50 years! As a result, Martin's International is dedicating its July 4th weekend, 26th African/Caribbean International Festival of Life (IFOL) in Chicago, the IRAWMA and its other events to TheReggae50 Celebration. – 2018/19.

The 1968 formation of the new Jamaican music genre "Reggae" Blossomed into international popularity in 1969. Martin's International is proposing that **TheReggae50** be multinational celebration throughout this year 2018 through the end of the year 2019.

meantime, the 36th IRAWMA winners will be presented on Sunday, March 18th, 2018, in conjunction with the 37th Annual Chicago Music Awards in Chicago, and will promote TheReggae50.

Ephraim Martin had also penned a Reggae50 song to help in the branding of TheReggae50. TheReggae50 song includes the names of some of the Reggae foundation entertainers. Martin believes that Jamaica can see its greatest tourism windfall and inflow of tourists within the next two years if TheReggae50 is properly branded and promoted globally.

Martin states, "There are approximately 2.5 billion fans of Reggae and World Music, who would love to discover Jamaica, during this period of <u>TheReggae50</u> Celebration. Reggae entertainers everywhere will reap the benefits from TheReggae50 Celebration 2018 – 2019 festivities."
